(License is valid for 60 days from the date of issuance, the validity of the license may be extended for 60 additional days if the licensee provides an affidavit to the municipal officers stating that all goods, ware or merchandise listed in the inventory have not been disposed of within the original 60-day period)

_____, Appeared and under oath, to the municipal officers that no merchandise will be included in the stock offered for sale unless the merchandise is in or at the place of business where the sale will take place when the sale opens. The applicant further understands that any unusual purchases and additions to the stock of goods, wares or merchandise made within 60 days before the filing of an application for a license is prima facie evidence that the purchases and additions were made in contemplation of the sale.

If the applicant has been in the same business for which the sale is being conducted for less than 2 years of continuous operation in the municipality, the applicant must also affirm, in writing and under oath, that none of the merchandise was purchased before the sale opened for the purpose of selling and disposing of that merchandise at the sale.

The applicant further understands that the municipal officers shall revoke any license issued under this subchapter if the licensee is convicted of violating this section. The municipal officers may refuse to issue another license to any applicant who has been convicted of violating this section before the date of application.
