

Individual Permit Form

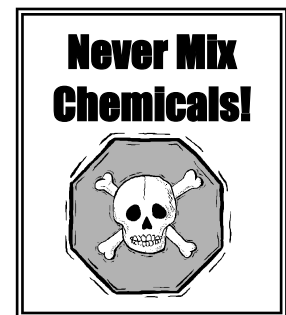
GREATER ELLSWORTH REGIONAL Household Hazardous Waste -- Universal Waste Collection

August 19, 2017 Ellsworth High School 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

This permit entitles a resident from **ELLSWORTH** to bring up to 10 gallons or 40 pounds of Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) plus other Universal Waste (UW) to the collection on Saturday, August 19, 2017 for disposal at no charge. Additional material can be brought to the collection for a fee, based on the amount of material that will be disposed of. The permit is valid for one visit only; **participants must have this permit to enter the site during the event.**

Instructions:

- Materials should be securely sealed with contents clearly marked. Original containers and labels are preferred.
- Materials should be placed in sturdy cardboard boxes (not just in bags) and transported to the site in a car trunk or pickup truck bed.
- Remain in your vehicle. Trained attendants will unload materials.
- **Materials will only be accepted between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM.**

Fuels (e.g. old gasoline, kerosene, charcoal lighter)		
Used motor oil (<i>please take this to your transfer station, for recycling if this service is available</i>)		
Used antifreeze/battery acid/ transmission fluid, brake fluid, contaminated oil and other automotive liquids.		
waxes, driveway sealer, adhesives		
Pool chemicals, photography chemicals		
Cleaners (e.g. oven cleaners, muriatic acid, drain cleaners)		
Herbicides/Pesticides/Fungicides		
Fluorescent bulbs, thermometers (include quantity of items)		
CRT's-- televisions/computer monitors
