HARBOR MASTER REPORT

There is a waiting list for everything, moorings, float docks, and slips. The final bid for the new fuel tank was \$309,015.30. Gaf Tek was the only bidder. The bid came in better than expected because the city allowed them plenty of lee way as to when they could do it. They are looking at a late fall completion date. The Harbor Master's hut needs to be heated year round to accommodate the Veeder Root tank monitoring system. Mark and Adam asked for a 10% increase to the harbor budget for the next fiscal year. We will June 6 if that is approved by the council.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The dock/float maintenance report should show a positive of \$9928.

COUNCIL REPORT

According to councilor Moore there is a neutral to positive attitude from the council as a whole towards the Harbor.

OLD BUSINESS

The Army Corps has determined there is heavy metal contamination in the river bed bottom where the channel is and would be if they change the location. This would require the spoils to be deposited on shore with the need to be de-watered.
