**HARBORMASTER REPORT:**

Record month for fuel sales – 4024 gals. – an increase of 1700 gals. over last season. Diesel, 457 sold. Community Band finished after a successful season in the Park. Fuel tank exhaust pipe has become a work of art with a nautical theme. The Union River waterway experienced the best Stripper run in MANY seasons!

**HARBOR FINANCIALS:** \$6000.00 of Invoices added to Balance in June.

**CITY COUNCIL:** No attendance. The Commission has requested improved communication and representation from the Council.

**DREDGE UPDATE:** Army Corp has finished a survey of the channel and the spoils site. City Manager reported that he is currently seeking more details from the Army Corp concerning the allocation of their \$4.3 million budgeted to the channel dredge scheduled FY 2023.

**CRIB REPAIR ESTIMATES:** Rough estimates received based on \$885 per hr. for a boom truck, or \$7,000 per day with mesh webbing sling, plus two riggers, to move rocks in place, based on moving 14 yds of materials to crib works. Suggested budget - \$15,000.00 FY 2024.

**HARBOR SIDEWALK RESTORATION:** Public works to receive estimates.

**AUTUMN GOLD:** Six boats lined up to provide pro bono River tours during the event.

**NEW BUSINESS:** None
