

ELLSWORTH ME HARBOR COMMISSION MINUTES, 10-22-25

Meeting Commenced @18:00 hrs. Ellsworth City Hall (FD Training Room)

Chairman Report: The Commission is grateful for Mark to be back at work.

Harbormaster Report: Received and approved.

- January 1st scheduled meeting with the Army Corp.
- *No wake Buoy* was located in Bathhouse storage by HM for possible future use.
- Kayak rental recommended for next season by HM. Commission discussed Kayak Harbor boundaries of use, and safety guidelines.
- Plans for four EV charging stations in Harbor parking area discussed regarding allocating appropriate parking spaces. The monthly return on charging fees is estimated at \$800.00 per month. The Commission requested that this funding be credited to the Harbor budget.
- HM will work on a new system to manage mooring holders status and location.
- Sunday Farmers Market will move to the Harbor next season.
- With the departure of the Salsa Shack the Harbor will need to put out a RFP for a new Vendor.

Dredge Update: No change since last report.

City Council: Not present.

Member Comments: John Noll recommends increasing launching ramp float extension, and/or adding more to the floats dog-leg at the end of the Ramp. This would particularly facilitate use of ramp floats for commercial boaters at low tide.
