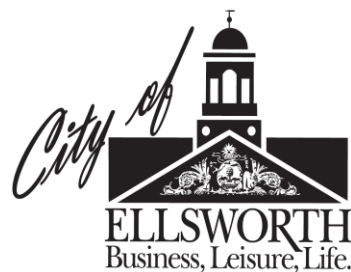

ARTICLE II GENERAL

...

~~The~~ An application fee for a special amusement permit ~~shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00); must be accompanied by a fee, as provided in Chapter 1, Article 3 (Fee Schedule and Special Fees).~~

...

Section 203. Suspension or Revocation of a Permit. The City Council may, ~~after a public hearing preceded by notice to interested parties,~~ suspend, or revoke any special amusement permits which have been issued under this ~~ordinance~~ Chapter 37 in accordance with the procedures in Chapter 1, Section 510 of the City Code, on the grounds that the music, dancing, or entertainment so permitted constitutes a detriment to the public health, safety or welfare, or violates any municipal ordinances, articles, bylaws, or rules or regulations.

~~Upon complaint or complaints of any person or persons that there are grounds to revoke said permit, and said complaint or complaints having been found by the City Council to be valid, after hearing as hereinbefore provided, the City Council may warn the licensee that unless the cause or causes of said complaints are removed forthwith, that said permit will be revoked or suspended after a subsequent hearing covering same.~~
